## New Air Ambulance Base from Redundant Site

Our brief was to convert a redundant site into a base for Yorkshire Air Ambulance which required the structural alteration of the existing building.

The work involved increasing the eaves height on a section of the rear elevation to facilitate the installation of enlarged access doors in order to accommodate the storage of the helicopter. The building was also modified to provide ancillary office accommodation for the ground crew to perform pre-flight checks and 'basic maintenance' of the helicopter.

A helicopter landing pad was constructed to the north east of the building together with a bunded fuel store.
