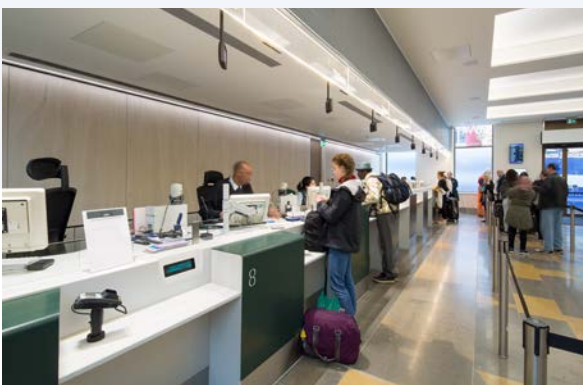

Realising the GWR Brand Vision

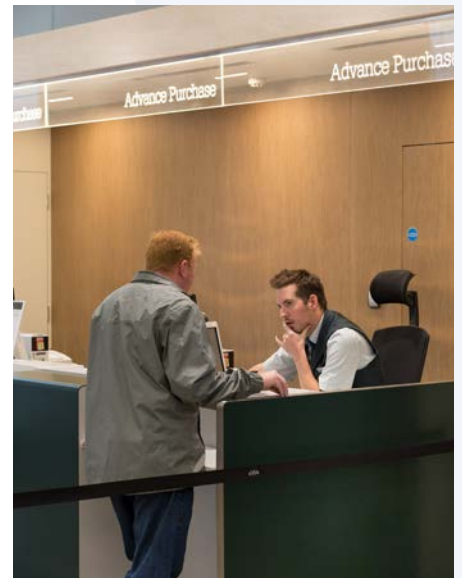
