# PARK HOUSE SCHOOL

## NEWBURY

Park House School is located on the south edge of Newbury and is a medium sized co-educational mixed Academy for 11-18 year old pupils.

Due to recent neighbouring residential development, there was a requirement to create three additional classrooms to ensure that the school will be able to cater for a predicted increase in pupil numbers.

The existing library is too small to cater for the needs of the school and has been relocated and enlarged within its own purpose built block. The new library extension links the existing Park House Building with the main school. The innovative roof design creates a light and airy naturally ventilated library space, for both teaching and storage of books.

There was also a requirement to increase accessibility to the Park House building through the provision of a new accessible WC. This WC also serves the new library space, which is of particular importance if it is to be run as an out of hours asset.
